Resolution No. 6

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 4 of King County Fire Protection District No. 34, the District is now prepared to issue, and The First National Bank of Redmond is prepared to purchase \$12,500. of Coupon Warrants therein authorized, and in said resolution it is provided that the proceeds of said warrants shall be expended in the following manner, to-wit:

Approximately \$11,000. for pumping engine and miscellaneous fire fighting equipment;

\$1500. for incidentals;

and

WHEREAS, in enacting said resolution the Board of Fire Commissioners included within the said item of incidentals the interest payable on said coupon warrants on July 1, 1949 and January 1, 1950, in the sum of \$468.75, but the break-down of the said items of incidentals is not shown in said resolution and it therefore does not specifically direct the payment of said \$468.75 into the Coupon Warrant Fund, although it was so intended in enacting said resolution and in enacting Resolution No. 5 establishing the various funds for the District, and it is desired to set the same forth at this time herein,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That out of the proceeds of the sale of said warrants there shall be paid into the coupon warrant fund the sum of \$468.75 which shall include the interest accrued on said Coupon Warrants on the date of the delivery thereof to The First National Bank of Redmond, said accrued interest

being payable by the said purchaser of said Coupon Warrants in addition to paying 100 percent of the par value of the Coupon Warrants; and said sum of \$468.75 shall be used to pay the Coupons falling due on said Warrants on July 1, 1949 and on January 1, 1950, as the same shall become due. The remainder of the purchase price of said Coupon Warrants shall be paid into the Contract Fund of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That Resolutions No. 4 and No. 5 of King County Fire Protection District No. 34 shall be and they are amended to conform herewith.

ADOPTED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 34 this 13th day of June, 1949.

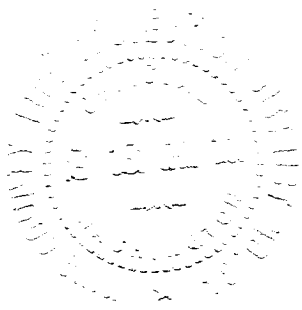
