

RESOLUTION

No. 14.

WHEREAS, a certain petition was on February 2, 1955, presented to the commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 10, King County, Washington, and has now been filed with and concurred in by the commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 34, King County, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the said petition prays for the withdrawal from said District 10, and merger with said District 34 of the following described real property in King County, Washington:

The southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22; the south $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 21; Sections 20 and 29; That portion of Section 19 lying northeasterly of Lake Sammamish. All in Township 25 N., range 6 east, W.M., TOGETHER WITH: All shorelands of the Second class abutting thereto.

under the terms and conditions therein stated, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington in such case made and provided; and

WHEREAS, the said petition was submitted to the Auditor, King County, Washington in accordance with law, and was thereafter found by such Auditor to fully comply with law in all respects, and to contain more than 60% of all of the qualified electors in the above-described area, and to be sufficient under the provisions of law, (RCW.52.24.100); and

WHEREAS, the law of the State of Washington requires that the Boards of Fire Commissioners of the merger and merging districts enact concurrent resolutions transferring the above-described land, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners for Fire Protection District No. 34, King County, Washington that the said above-described area be and it shall henceforth be a part of the said Fire Protection District No. 34 and is no longer part of the said Fire Protection District No. 10.
