RESOLUTION NO. 24

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 34 AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, The Commissioners determined on October 1, 1959, to convert the present tank truck into a pumper at an approximate cost of \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the balance of the funds and taxes into the Reserve Fund will be needed for the construction of a fire station in the Sherwood Forest area of the District; Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Fire Commissioners as follows:

- 1. That the balance of the funds presently within the Reserve Fund of the District as of October 1, 1959, is the approximate sum of \$9,300.00 and shall be transferred to the Expense Fund of the District.**
- 2. That all subsequent funds received from taxes into the Reserve Fund by virtue of the budget adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners on October 1, 1959, shall be transferred from the Reserve Fund into the Expense Fund of said district.**
- 3. That the Reserve Fund be closed out and all future taxes levied and collected into the Reserve Fund of said District be transferred to the Expense Fund of the said District.**

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire District No. 34, King County, this 12 day of April, 1960.

REVISED BUDGET
KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 34

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 34 AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the County Assessor has notified the Commissioners of Fire District No. 34 that the assessed valuation of real properties lying within the boundaries of said District for the calendar year 1960 is \$5,856,215.00.
2. That the attached hereto Exhibit "A" (by this reference made a part of this resolution) be and hereby is adopted as the budget of King County Fire District No. 34 for the calendar year 1960.
3. That the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, be and are hereby requested to make a levy for 1960 for said Fire District No. 34 of \$25,243.10.
4. That the County Treasurer of King County, Washington, be and hereby is authorized and directed to deposit and sequester the monies received from the collection of the tax levy specified in Section 3 above in the amounts and funds specified below:
 - A. \$3,934.31 into the Coupon Warrant Fund of said District.
 - B. \$21,308.74 into the Expense Fund of said District, or 3.5 mills.
