RESOLUTION NO. 27

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 34 AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, there remains a balance of funds in the Coupon Warrant Fund of said district which is needed for capital expenditures in connection with the building of a new Fire Station including miscellaneous equipment; and

WHEREAS, said funds are unnecessary to the district's operation; now therefore,

BE IT ENCLOSED by the Board of Fire Commissioners as follows:

1. That the balance of the funds presently within the Coupon Warrant Fund of the District as of September 1, 1961, is the approximate sum of \$402.53 and shall be transferred to the Expense Fund of the District.
2. That all subsequent funds received from taxes into the Coupon Warrant Fund by virtue of the budget adopted by the Board of Fire Commissioners on September 22, 1960, shall be transferred from said Fund into the Expense Fund of said District.
3. That the Coupon Warrant Fund be closed out and all future taxes levied and collected into the Coupon Warrant Fund of said District be transferred to the Expense Fund of the said District.
