


KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 34

RESOLUTION NO. 31/63

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 34 as follows:

1. That the District approved a proposal by the West Coast Telephone Company to install the latest type telephone fire alarm system.
2. That the District approved said alarm system at the regular meeting held on July 12th, 1960.
3. That the alarm system includes the private telephones of certain firemen in the Department.
4. That public use and necessity required changing private telephones of certain firemen from multiple party lines to private or two party lines.
5. That said change increased the cost of private telephone service of certain firemen, which cost would normally not have increased had it not been for the fire alarm system.
6. That the Board of Fire Commissioners, therefore, will pay the difference between the cost of telephone service prior to the installation of the alarm system and the cost since the installation of the alarm system, excluding normal tariff increases.
