RESOLUTION NO. 52/67

A RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY
TO JEFFERSON COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 3.

WHEREAS, King County Fire District No. 34 is a municipal corporation acting as a fire district in the Redmond, King County area, and has received an offer from Jefferson County Fire Protection District No. 3, a fire district rendering service in the Port Ludlow, Jefferson County area, to purchase a certain 1955 International Model S180, Class A Pumper, 600 GPM, 3-stage Hi Pressure Pump midship, 500 Gal. Tank, fully equipped, Serial No. 1455 (Engine No. 3) for the sum of \$7,500.00; and

WHEREAS, the said fire truck is no longer suitable for the needs of King County Fire District No. 34 and is surplus to their needs at the present time and excess to the foreseeable needs of King County Fire District No. 34 in the future;

Now, therefore, it is hereby determined as follows:

1. That said fire truck is surplus to the needs of King County Fire District No. 34.
2. That the price offered by Jefferson County Fire District No. 3 in the sum of \$7,500.00 is a reasonable and fair price for the vehicle in its present condition, and it is acceptable to Jefferson County Fire District No. 3.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by King County Fire District No. 34 that, subject to the approval of the Superior Court for King County, Washington, pursuant to Chapter 133, Section 1, Laws of 1953, the aforementioned transfer be, and the same is hereby approved on the terms and conditions hereinbefore set forth.
