RESOLUTION NO. 86/75

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION

WHEREAS, the District has planned to purchase a new fire truck to replace worn-out equipment, and

WHEREAS, funds in excess of those available to the District are required for the purpose of purchasing a new piece of fire apparatus and cost of general District Maintenance and Operations, and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that funds will be required in the sum of \$ 94,000.00, which will require a levy rate of .74 of one (1) Mill (based upon an assessment rate of 100% of actual value) to be placed upon all taxable property within the District in Excess of the annual levy permitted without a vote of the people, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That, the Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 34 direct that the King County Office of Records and Elections place upon the Ballot for the September 16, 1975 Primary Election the proposition for a special Levy for the purpose of purchasing Fire Apparatus and for Fire Department Maintenance and Operations, in the following form:

PROPOSITION
FOR FIRE APPARATUS, MAINTENANCE
AND OPERATIONS LEVY

Shall a tax of approximately ~~74~~ ^{0.74} of one ~~mill~~ ^{mill} (based upon an assessment rate of 100% of actual value) be levied for the District's Expense Fund upon all taxable property within King County Fire Protection District No. 34, King County, Washington, in excess of the annual levy permitted the District without a vote of the people, such levy to be made in 1975 for collection in 1976 for the purpose of providing \$ 94,000.00 to purchase a new fire apparatus and to pay part of the general expenses of maintenance and operations of the District in 1976 and the proceeds of such levy used during said year, all as provided in a Resolution of the Board of Commissioners adopted July 7, 1975. ?
