A RESOLUTION TO GIVE WRITTEN CONSENT FOR
THE DISPOSAL OR REPLACEMENT OF PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Paragraph 6 of the conditions of the Fire Protection Service Contract between the fire district and the City of Redmond provides for the written consent of the fire district to the City of Redmond when it becomes desirable to dispose or replace any property of the fire district, and

WHEREAS, the fire district called for bids for a new fire truck, and

WHEREAS, the bid of Western States Fire Apparatus was accepted, and

WHEREAS, Western States Fire Apparatus agreed to a trade-in allowance of \$26,500.00 toward the purchase price of the new fire truck for the fire district's 1964 Crown Pumper, Serial No. F1366, and therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That, the Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 34 give their consent to the City of Redmond to dispose of the 1964 Crown Pumper, Serial No. F 1366, by trading it in on the new fire truck purchased from Western States Fire Apparatus.
