WHEREAS, the Commissioners deem that it would be to the benefit of the District, the residents therein, and the residents of the area to be annexed, if such Petition were approved, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 34, concur in the Petition for Annexation, and direct that same be filed with the King County Council and its Auditor, and with the King County Boundary Review Board for action in accordance with RCW 52.08.060 and RCW Chapter 36.93.
