A RESOLUTION TO GIVE WRITTEN CONSENT TO THE DISPOSAL OR
REPLACEMENT OF PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Paragraph 6 of the contract between King County Fire Protection District #34 and the City of Redmond, dated January 1, 1974 provides for the written consent of the Fire District when it becomes desirable to dispose or replace any of the property of the District, and

WHEREAS, under the terms of this contract the Fire District had transferred to the City of Redmond (1) a 1971 Dodge equipment truck, serial number D31BE1S364792 and (2) a 1977 Dodge mini pumper, serial number D31BJ7S034514, and

WHEREAS, both vehicles have served its useful purpose and have been replaced by a new and more efficient unit to serve the community, now therefore,


