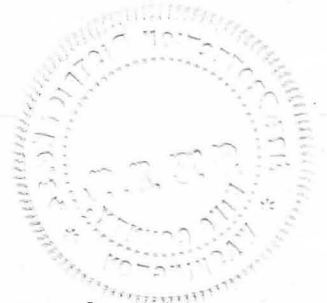


RESOLUTION # 128/88

ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL FIRE
PROTECTION REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION

9-6-88



WHEREAS: KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT # 34 understands the importance of assuring that efficient and uniform fire protection is available throughout King County; and

WHEREAS: KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT # 34 desires to protect the health, safety and welfare of the general public from the ravishes of fire; and

WHEREAS: Limited public funds are available for the establishment of fire protection and suppression capabilities by Fire Districts; and

WHEREAS: Recognizing funds are limited, in the judgment of KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT # 34, the overall health, safety and welfare interest of the public would be best served by adopting the Fire Protection Requirements prepared by the King County Fire Chief's and Commissioners Growth Management Committee; and

WHEREAS: R.C.W. 52.12.031(4) encourages uniformity and coordination of Fire Protection District Operations, Inspections and Code Enforcements.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT # 34 request that King County Council adopt the provisions of the Fire Protection Requirements submitted by the Joint Growth Management Committee so that uniformity of Public Fire Protection interest may be served.
