

RESOLUTION NO. 133/89

A resolution to give written consent to the disposal or replacement of property.

WHEREAS, paragraph 6 of the contract between King County Fire District #34 and the City of Redmond, dated Jan., 1, 1974, provides for the written consent of the fire district when it becomes desirable to dispose or replace any of the property of the district, and


WHEREAS, under the terms of this contract the fire district had transferred to the City of Redmond a 1967 Crown fire coach 1500 gpm pumper, serial number F1492, and

WHEREAS, this engine has served its useful purpose and has been determined surplus, now therefore



BE IT RESOLVED, that the commissioners of King County Fire Protection District #34 give their consent to the City of Redmond to dispose of the 1967 Crown with all proceeds being deposited into the Fire Department Apparatus Replacement Fund.
