RESOLUTION TO GRANT NATIVE GROWTH PROTECTION EASEMENT
TO KING COUNTY BUILDING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT DIVISION

WHEREAS, King County Fire Protection District No. 34 intends to build a fire station on the following described real property:

The West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/14 of Section 15; Township 25 North; Range 6 East; W.M.: King County, Washington; less County Road and less the 30.00 feet thereof; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to King County Building and Land Development Division Zoning Adjustor Report and Decision File No. 89-25-C, the District must grant, convey and warrant to King County, State of Washington a native growth protection easement on said property in order to obtain the required construction permits; and

WHEREAS, a native growth protection easement has been prepared in compliance with the instructions of King County Building and Land Development Division, now therefore it is hereby

RESOLVED by the King County Fire Protection District No. 34 Board of Commissioners that the Native Growth Protection Easement a copy of which is attached hereto be executed;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said easement be recorded with the King County Recorder's Office with a copy of the same being delivered to the King County Building and Land Development Division.
