

Resolution No. 158/95

A Resolution of King County Fire Protection District 34, Washington, withdrawing their petition this 6th day of March, 1995 to merge or contract for services with King County Fire District 10 effective January 1, 1996.

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners for King County Fire Protection District 34 had petitioned, on August 30, 1994, King County Fire Protection District 10 for merger or contract; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners have been able to resolve all issues with the City Of Redmond on which the petition was first based and was given to King County Fire District 10 ;and

Whereas, the petition is a request of King County Fire Protection District 34 to King County Fire Protection District 10; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners now find a new contractual agreement with the City of Redmond to be beneficial to the citizens of Fire District 34; and

Whereas, the responsibility of the Board of Commissioners is to provide the citizens with the best possible emergency services; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Board of Commissioners to fulfill their elected duties and responsibilities, now, therefore,

The Board of Commissioners of King County Fire District 34, Washington, hereby resolve,






