A Resolution of King County Fire Protection District 34, Washington, to fund two firefighter positions in addition to the regular contract amount paid to the City of Redmond under the Emergency Services Operating Agreement, these firefighters will be used to reduce overtime cost and begin to address staffing levels at Station 14.

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners for King County Fire Protection District 34 have contracted with the City of Redmond for emergency services; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners have met with the City Council and Mayor in the Fire Services Forum to discuss the resource needs of the fire department; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners have contract terms which allows for additional funding of needed and desired resources for the fire department; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners find it to be in the best interest of the public to additionally fund resources for the fire department; and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Board of Commissioners to fulfill their elected duties and responsibilities, now, therefore,

The Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34, Washington, hereby resolve,

Section 1. King County Fire Protection District 34 shall fully fund two full time firefighter positions from March 1, 1996 through the remaining contract period with the City of Redmond. The funding shall be in addition to the regular contracted amount as identified in the Emergency Services Operating Agreement between the City and Fire District. The funding beyond the contract period of the Emergency Service Operating Agreement shall be negotiated as an issue during contract renewal discussions.
