

KING COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT 34  
REDMOND, WASHINGTON

RESOLUTION 169/97

A RESOLUTION expressing the intent of the District to work cooperatively with King County Fire Districts 10 and 27 during the incorporation of a city on the Sammamish Plateau.

WHEREAS, Fire Districts 10, 27, and 34 have jointly provided fire protection and emergency medical services to the Sammamish Plateau area for more than 50 years; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Districts have a well established and cooperative working relationship with each other that includes both mutual and automatic aid; and

WHEREAS, there is currently an effort underway to create a new city covering a majority of the Sammamish Plateau; and

WHEREAS, if a new city is approved, the Fire Districts will continue to provide services for an interim period after incorporation while the new city selects a permanent provider of fire protection and emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Districts believe that cooperation during the process to create a new city and through the interim period following incorporation will enhance the delivery of fire protection and emergency medical services during that time and will facilitate the new city's selection of a provider of permanent services; and

WHEREAS, each of the Fire Districts will indicate its intent to support the provisions of this resolution by adopting identical resolutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, by this resolution the Fire Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District No. 34, King County, Redmond, Washington, resolve that Fire District 34 will:

1. Work cooperatively with Fire Districts 10 and 27 to continue to provide fire protection and emergency medical services in the Sammamish Plateau area during the process to approve and incorporate a new city in the area; and
2. Share information with Fire Districts 10 and 27, the persons involved in the city approval process, and the new city so that the new city will be able to make an informed decision regarding the provider of permanent fire protection and emergency medical services.
