**RESOLUTION TO SURPLUS AND DISPOSE OF 1984 MODULINE INDUSTRIES  
65' X 14' MOBILE HOME**

**WHEREAS**, King County Fire Protection District 34 has determined that a 1984 Moduline Industries 65' x 14' mobile home, Serial #9-7199, is no longer needed by the District; that this mobile home, though in fair condition, is functionally obsolete for this District because, inter alia, the District no longer has a need to temporarily house firefighters; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Fire Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of King County Fire Protection District 34 to surplus and dispose of the said 1984 Moduline Industries 65' x 14' mobile home, Serial #9-7199; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds it likely that this mobile home will meet the needs and be suitable for the purposes of construction firms; and further that because of this limited market, it may be more efficient and more productive to sell this mobile home on a negotiated basis; now therefore it is

**RESOLVED** by the King County Fire Protection District 34 Board of Commissioners that the 1984 Moduline Industries 65' x 14' mobile home, Serial #9-7199, together with on-board and associated equipment, be and is hereby declared surplus to the needs of the District; and it is further

**RESOLVED** that said items shall be disposed of by sale in a commercially reasonable manner to be determined by the Chief of the District.
