A RESOLUTION of King County Fire Protection District 34, adopting a 2.57% increase in the Fire District Pay Plans for Office Technician and District Secretary effective January 1, 2005

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire District 34 considers parity in benefits as beneficial to employee morale; and

WHEREAS, the district employees will be working routinely with City of Redmond employees;

RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire District 34 that Pay Plan A0-1 and Pay Plan A0-2 be increased by 2.57% from the 2004 levels.

PASSED by the Board of Fire Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34 on January 27, 2005.


