# KING COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT 34 SPECIAL COMMISSIONERS' MEETING – PUBLIC HEARING

#### November 7, 2006

I. Call to Order – A special meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners of King County Fire District 34 was called to order at 5:03 p.m. on Tuesday, November 7, 2006, at Station 11, located at 8450 161<sup>st</sup> Avenue N.E., Redmond, Washington.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss King County Fire District 34's anticipated 2007 revenues and proposed tax levy.

- II. Roll Call Chairman Thomas Johnston, Commissioner Peter Lucarelli, Commissioner Sherman Colson, Attorney Kinnon Williams, and District Secretary Anne Carlson were present.
- III. Approval of Agenda

Motion from Commissioner Colson to approve the November 7, 2006 agenda. Motion seconded by Commissioner Lucarelli. Motion passed unanimously.

- IV. Public Comments None
- V. 2006 Budget Review Chairman Johnston reported that he reviewed all 2006 expenditures and developed a summary. The amount of excess overtime is unknown at this time. The City has funded an additional \$500,000 for 2006 overtime. The District's share of the overage could be \$200,000 to \$300,000. Chairman Johnston reviewed each line item. The City's budget has not been adopted, so the 2007 contract payment is an estimate. Not reflected is the possibility of the city hiring more firefighters to staff a dedicated aid car at Station 12 and to staff Station 17 when it is built. There are also CIP funds for Station 14's siding and roof repairs.

The District's budget would increase from \$4.35 million to \$4.76 million if the City hires the proposed eight firefighters from the general fund. The commissioners agreed to fund the 2007 overtime overage line item with \$50,000 and increase the PERS 2 line item to \$3,000. The commissioners agreed to add \$50,000 for election expenses for a potential vote on additional staffing. The proposed budget would be \$4,977,950.

- VI. Proposed 2007 Revenues and Tax Levy It is anticipated that a levy rate of \$1.21 per \$1,000 would create revenue of \$5.1 million and would cover the proposed budget, city costs, and some funds for reserve. It was noted that the new construction amount decreased this year. The commissioners are considering an increase of 22.87%, which would equal \$922,952 over the previous year.
- VII. Adjournment Commissioner Johnston adjourned the special meeting at 6:25 p.m.
