RESOLUTION 258/10

A RESOLUTION of King County Fire Protection District 34 Approving an Interlocal Agreement with the Flood Control Zone District and King County Fire District 34 to Protect Levy Capacity

WHEREAS, the King County Flood Control District requested the Fire District to enter into an Interlocal Levy Agreement with Fire District 34 which provides that the Fire District's regular property taxes for collection in calendar year 2011 will not reduce the amount of the Flood District's regular property taxes levied for collection in calendar year 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34 finds it is appropriate and reasonably necessary to maintain Flood Control Zone District service levels;


WHEREAS, due consideration has been given to the terms and provisions of the Interlocal Levy Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that entry into this agreement will be in the best interests of its citizens and will not have an adverse impact on Fire District finances;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by King County Fire District 34 that the Interlocal Levy Agreement with King County Flood Control Zone District is approved and the motion made at the October 26, 2010 meeting of the Board of Commissioners authorizing entry into the agreement is hereby ratified by resolution.
