Resolution No. 5

WHEREAS, King County Fire Protection District No. 34 is a Fire Protection District duly organized, existing, and operating under the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of ~~March~~^{APRIL}, 1949, Resolution No. 4 of this Board, providing for the procurement of a pumping engine and miscellaneous fire fighting equipment together with other incidentals and for the issuance of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred (\$12,500) Dollars King County Fire Protection District No. 34 Coupon Warrants, Series A, was passed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That pursuant to the provisions of Section ~~554~~-134 (Remington's Revised Statutes of Washington, 1947 Supplement) the following funds are prescribed and established for King County Fire Protection District No. 34:

1. Expense Fund. All taxes levied for administrative, operative, and maintenance purposes, when collected, shall be placed by the County Treasurer in the Expense Fund of said District. All vouchers approved by this Board for the administrative, operative, and maintenance purposes of said District shall be drawn against the Expense Fund.

2. Coupon Warrant Fund. All taxes levied for the payment of Coupon Warrants and interest thereon, when collected, shall be placed by the County Treasurer in the Coupon Warrant Fund of said District.

3. Contract Fund. All taxes levied for the purchase of fire fighting equipment, apparatus and for the housing thereof, proceeds from the sale of Coupon Warrants, and the transfer of any surplus in the Expense Fund, shall be placed by the County Treasurer

in the Contract Fund of said District. All vouchers approved by this Board for the purchase of fire fighting equipment, apparatus and for the housing thereof for said District shall be drawn against the Contract Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the County Treasurer and the County Auditor be and hereby are authorized and requested to create the funds above described.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That duplicate original executed copies of this Resolution be delivered to the County Auditor and County Treasurer respectively of King County.
