RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CRITERIA FOR
RECOGNIZING LONGEVITY OF SERVICE

WHEREAS, fire districts employ individuals and are governed by boards of fire commissioners who commit countless hours in the performance of their duties; and

WHEREAS, due to the nature of the position and the relatively small amount of compensation being paid to those serving as commissioners, it is difficult to find individuals serving longer than one term (a period of six years); and

WHEREAS, in an era of workforce mobility and transitory employment it is beneficial to the District to have a stable workforce;

WHEREAS, in recognition of those rare individuals who have served the District for a period of twenty-five years;

THE BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES that any individuals serving the District for a period of twenty-five years shall be awarded a bronze plaque commemorating their years of service and in recognition of the countless hours spent on behalf of the District and their dedication to the citizens that it serves.


