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**RESOLUTION NO. 328-21**

**2022 PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

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**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34 has properly given notice of the public hearing held November 16, 2021 to consider the Fire District's current expense budget for the 2022 calendar year, pursuant to [RCW 84.55.120](#); and


**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34, after hearing, and after duly considering all relevant evidence and testimony presented, has determined that King County Fire Protection District 34 requires an increase in property tax revenue from the previous year, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, in order to discharge the expected expenses and obligations of the fire district and in its best interest; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District 34 that an increase in the regular property tax levy, in addition to the increase resulting from the addition of new construction and improvements to property and any increase in the value of state-assessed property, is hereby authorized for the 2022 levy in the amount of \$ 83,231 which is a percentage increase of 1.05 % from the previous year.
